





This trustee report will cover our activities from 01 January 2018 thru 31 December 2018. As you will hopefully see, the trustees had a very busy year.

- 2. Cleaned 750 air vent covers
- 3. Inspected and tested 186 emergency exit lights for functionality
- 4. Inspected 84 fire extinguishers
- 5. Evacuated water from both HVAC drain trays multiple times in Sanctuary
- 6. Repaired both HVAC drain lines
- 7. Replaced several defective ceiling tiles in Education Building
- 8. Replaced 6 fluorescent light bulbs in Education Building
- 9. Fire alarm errors were all corrected
- 10. Replaced 18 emergency exit light batteries
- 11. Replaced 1 emergency exit light battery
- 12. Repaired 4 exit doors in Sanctuary
- 13. Repaired commode in women's restroom in Sanctuary
- 14. Repaired commode in men's restroom in Sanctuary
- 15. Repaired commode in men's restroom in Education Building
- 16. Repaired commode in men's restroom in Fellowship Hall
- 17. Found the 6 HVAC units behind the Education Building vandalized-Police report filed with the Johnston County Sheriff's Office on Friday, 12 October 2018-Sheriff's Office temporarily installed 2 cameras to catch those responsible
- 18. Ordered 18 HVAC air fin covers to keep air fins from further damage
- 19. Temporarily repaired vinyl siding on Education Building
- 20. Had sump pump cleaned and emptied
- 21. Had both backflow preventers recertified for 2018
- 22. Replaced 3 door closer assemblies
- 23. Replaced several defective ceiling tiles in Education Building
- 24. Replaced 2 ceiling light bulbs in Sanctuary
- 25. Obtained 2 quotes for Sanctuary carpet cleaning. Neither was accepted
- 26. Completely replaced 1 florescent light fixture in Fellowship Hall kitchen
- 27. Completely replaced 1 florescent light fixture in Education Building
- 28. HVAC units at all buildings inspected and cleaned per spring contract
- 29. HVAC units at all buildings inspected and cleaned per fall contract
- 30. Replaced battery in emergency exit light in Education Building
- 31. Replaced burned wiring for defective lamp on outside of Sanctuary

- 33. Cleaned and straightened out front storage room under picnic shelter
- 34. Repaired both $\frac{1}{2}$ doors in Children's Nursery so they would close easier
- 35. Repaired 2nd floor stairwell railing in Education Building
- 36. Repaired commode in women's restroom in Sanctuary
- 37. Repaired commode in men's restroom in Sanctuary
- 38. Replaced fluorescent lights inside of outdoor church sign (Thanks to Allen)
- 39. Replaced defective ceiling exhaust fan in women's restroom in Sanctuary
- 40. Had Fire Suppression System recertified twice (every 6 months)
- 41. Had our fire alarms for the Sanctuary & Education Building inspected & certified
- 42. Had the Clayton Fire Marshal perform the annual fire inspection
- 43. Replaced the photo cell timer for the flag pole light (<u>Thanks to Allen</u>)
- 44. Cleaned out the detention ponds multiple times
- 45. Ordered new wall pack light for top of rear door of Education Building
- 46. Ordered 2 new photo cell devices for 2 wall pack lights at Education Building
- 47. Replaced 12 expired fire extinguishers with new ones per NFPA/NC Fire Code
- 48. Replaced leaking kitchen sink faucet & sprayer in Activity Room

Your trustees are working on several exciting & beneficial items for your church. More details will soon be provided.




